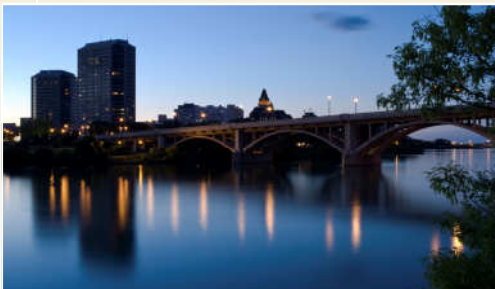

The contest is open to all amateur and professional photographers, including SREDA members and contestants may enter as often as they wish. The submission deadline is **September 30, 2008**, so get out there and start snapping!

- **Saskatoon:** capturing the essence of the City.
- **Business:** mining, manufacturing, science, research, business
- **Recreation/Nature:** sports/general activities, golf, skate parks, Forestry farm, winter fun, camping, etc.
- **Education-themed:** includes elementary, high school and post-secondary subjects
- **Health/Services:** life sciences, health care
- **Culture:** fine & performing arts, multicultural communities, handicrafts etc.

- **Quality of image**
- **Subject matter:** how the photo represents the best of the Saskatoon region
- **Strong subject matter, design, bright colours**
- **Clarity of subject and photo**
